

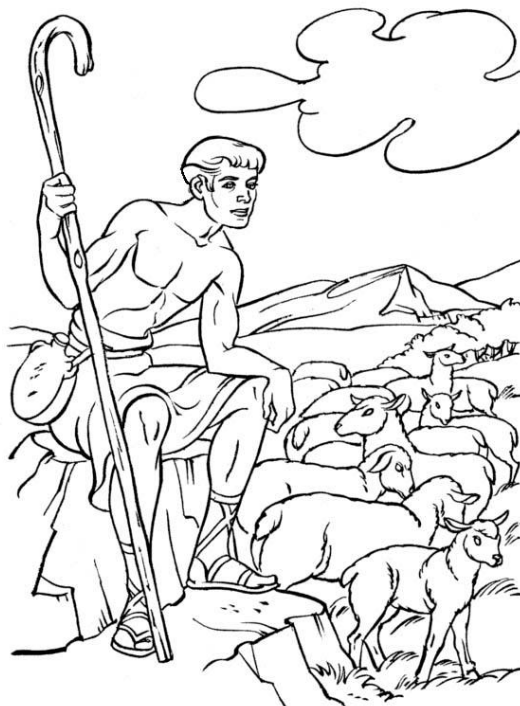
# Cain, Abel and Seth

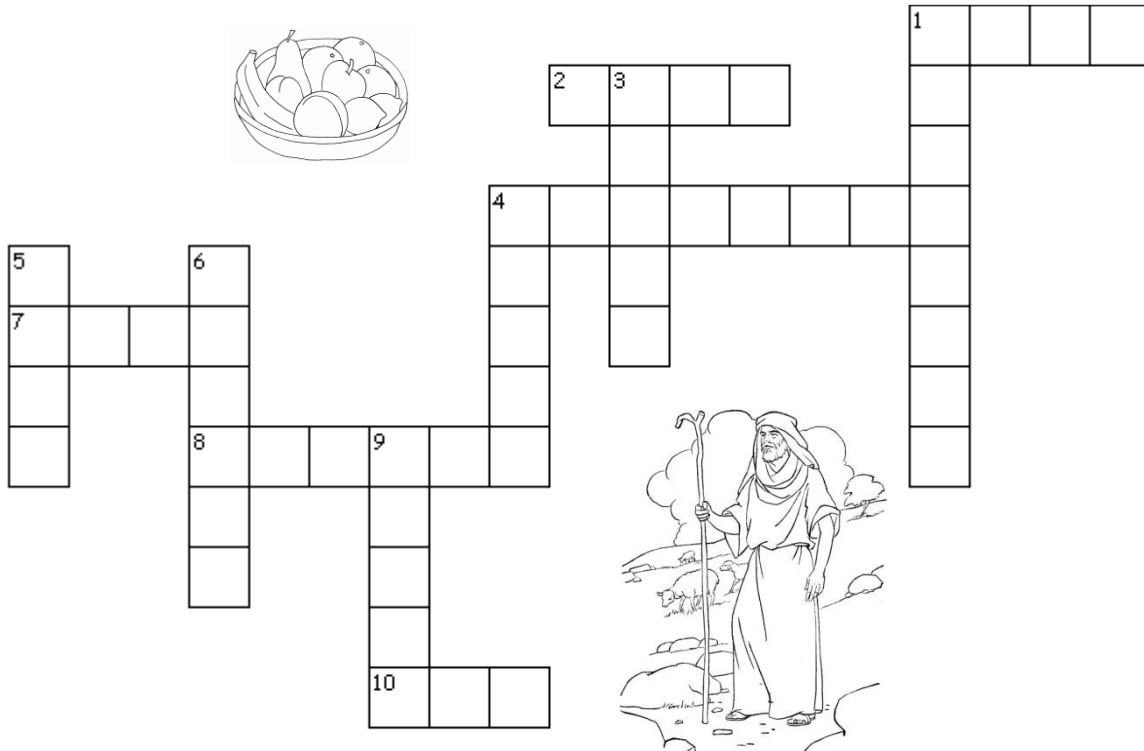
