### Instructions

- Print out clue cards and backings (Optional).
- Cut out the cards and backing with a pair of scissors.
- (Optional) Glue the picture backing to the back of the card.

**\*Another Option: For longer lasting cards laminate or print out on card stock\***

### How to Play

- **Objective:** Discussion game on possible scenarios that may occur through interaction with people in daily life situations.
- Start the game by mixing up the cards.
- Decide who will read the cards first.
- There are two possible ways to play; you can either discuss as a group or individually.

<p>During the month of December, you are at the checkout line in the grocery store and the cashier says to you, “Merry Christmas!”</p> <p><b>What would you say?</b></p>	<p>During a conversation the question comes up, “if there is no eternal hell fire, why does 1 Peter 3:18-20 say that Messiah preached to the souls detained in Hades?”</p> <p><b>What would your answer be?</b></p>
<p>Someone asks...</p> <p>On Yom Kippur fast day, should the unbaptized members fast together with the baptized in fellowship?</p> <p><b>What is your answer?</b></p>	<p>Someone asks...</p> <p>Can you have the Holy Spirit in you without the laying on of hands?</p> <p><b>What is your answer?</b></p>
<p>Someone asks...</p> <p>Why do you keep the feasts? They are interested and want to know more.</p> <p><b>How would you respond?</b></p>	<p>Your neighbor is having a birthday celebration for their child and invites you come over and celebrate.</p> <p><b>What would you say to them?</b></p>
<p>I am a new believer and I was told that the Sabbath is not Saturday but changes every month to a different day depending on the moon.</p> <p><b>How would you explain the Sabbath day?</b></p>	<p>During a conversation, someone asks, “Why were the people resurrected in Matthew 27:52-53, when the Messiah died?”</p> <p><b>What is your answer?</b></p>
<p>During a conversation, someone says, “the law was nailed to the cross!”</p> <p><b>What is your answer to this statement?</b></p>	<p>During a conversation, someone says, “my mom (or dad) is looking down on me from Heaven”</p> <p><b>How would you explain to them that Heaven is not promised?</b></p>

<p>You are meeting with distant family you never met before and they are cooking dinner for you. You have politely told them ahead of time you don't eat pork, but when you arrive you find that the main dish has pork in it.</p> <p><b>What would you do and how would you explain why you don't eat pork?</b></p>	<p>For the men...someone asks...</p> <p>What is hanging off of your shirt? (tassels)</p> <p><b>What would you say?</b></p> <p>Num 15:39, Deut 22:12</p>
<p>For the men... A Jewish man asks...</p> <p>Why are you wearing tassels, but not a kippah (yamaka)?</p> <p><b>How would you answer him?</b></p>	<p>For the ladies. Someone asks...</p> <p>I noticed you are always wearing a skirt. Is there a reason why?</p> <p><b>How would you answer?</b></p> <p>Deut 22:5</p>
<p><b>Explain the family Name of YAHWEH.</b></p>	<p>Someone says...</p> <p>I believe that the Messiah and the Father are the same being.</p> <p><b>How would you explain truth to them?</b></p>
<p>Someone says...</p> <p>I don't believe the Messiah was born of a virgin.</p> <p><b>How would you explain truth to them?</b></p>	<p>Someone asks...</p> <p>If Yahshua was Messiah, why are there still sacrifices in the millennial kingdom?</p> <p><b>Please explain.</b></p>
<p>A new believer asks...</p> <p>Is barley the only parameter to starting the biblical year?</p> <p><b>What is your answer?</b></p>	<p>A new believer asks...</p> <p>I have an unbelieving spouse, should I leave him/her?</p> <p><b>What is your answer?</b></p>
<p>Someone asks...</p> <p>In 2 Cor 12:2, Paul said, there is a man who was taken up to heaven. Who is that man?</p> <p><b>What is your answer?</b></p> <p>2 Cor 12:1, John 3:13</p>	<p>Please explain Matthew 10:28. If there is no separate soul, then why do the scriptures say HE can destroy both body and soul in Gehenna?</p> <p><b>What is your answer?</b></p> <p>Gen 2:7</p>

<p>Someone says...</p> <p>In 2 Kings 2:11, it says that Elijah was taken up in a whirlwind to heaven.</p> <p><b>How do you respond?</b></p> <p>John 3:13, 2 Chron 21:12, 1 Kings 18:11-12, 2 Kings 2:16</p>	<p>Please explain Math 24:40-41, "At that time two will be out in the field; the one is taken away, and the one is left; two grinding at the mill; one is taken away, and one is left.</p> <p>Is this the rapture, and who are taken and to where, and who are left?</p> <p>Matt 24:29-31, Luke 17:34-37, Matt 13:40-42</p>
<p>Where does the soul of the believer go at death?</p> <p><b>What is your answer?</b></p> <p>Rom 6:23, Ezek 18:4, Ex 31:14, Matt 10:28, Gen 2:7,16,17</p>	<p>Someone asks...</p> <p>How can I enter into the New Covenant?</p> <p><b>How would you answer?</b></p> <p>Matt 3:1-3, Acts 2:37-38, 1 John 3:4, Acts 8:36-37, Rom 8:9-11, 14-17, Rom 10:9-10, 1 Peter 3:18-21, Matt 16:16, Acts 8:12-19,</p>

So I don't need to keep the feasts. Those are for the Jewish people."</p> <p><b>What would you say?</b></p>
<p>During a conversation about creation, someone says, "It's hard to believe that creation was completed in only 7 days"</p> <p><b>Can you explain the truth about creation to them?</b></p>	<p>During a conversation, the question comes up... Didn't all human life come from Adam and Eve?</p> <p><b>What is your answer?</b></p>

<p>Does the bible teach that the soul is immortal, and that people are re-incarnated after death?</p> <p><b>What would you say?</b></p> <p>Ecc 9:5, Acts 7:60, John 11:11, 1 Thess 4:14, Ezek 18:4, Rom 6:23, Jacob 1:14, Matt 10:28</p>	<p>Someone says...</p> <p>My pastor is a woman and she knows her bible.</p> <p><b>What would you say?</b></p> <p>1 Cor 14:34-35, 1 Tim 22:11-15, Judges 21:25, Matt 26:39</p>
<p>A family member asks, "Why don't you keep the Sabbath the way the Jews do?"</p> <p><b>What is your answer?</b></p>	<p>After a recent encounter with a Jewish man, he explained to you that Isaiah 53 was about the nation of Israel and not about the Messiah.</p> <p><b>What should you have said to him?</b></p>
<p>According to Acts 20:7, it says that Paul and at the disciples were meeting on the first day of the week (Sunday). Doesn't that prove the Sabbath was changed to Sunday?</p> <p><b>What's your answer?</b></p>	<p>Someone says...</p> <p>I thought Paul started the new church.</p> <p><b>How would you respond to that statement?</b></p>
<p>You have explained to your family that you do not celebrate Christmas. Because they did not want to leave you out of the family gift giving, they leave you a give a gift wrapped in plain paper.</p> <p><b>What would you do and what would you say to them?</b></p>	<p>Someone asks...</p> <p>Is Yahshua, who is the Son of Yahweh, a created being or is He eternal like the Father without beginning or end?</p> <p><b>What is your answer?</b></p> <p>John 1:1-3, 14, 17:5, Micah 5:2, Psm 68:4-5, Gen 1:26, Ecc 12:1, Isa 48:16, Gen 18:1-2, Gen 19:24</p>
<p>Someone asks...</p> <p>Why is so important to be baptized? Can't I just accept Messiah in my heart?</p> <p><b>What is your answer?</b></p>	<p>Someone asks...</p> <p>Can you lose your salvation?</p> <p><b>What is your answer?</b></p>
<p>Someone asks...</p> <p>Why are there two resurrections mentioned in the bible?</p> <p><b>Can you explain?</b></p>	<p>Someone says...</p> <p>It says in Mark 2:28, that the Son of Man is the Master of the Sabbath. <i>They are trying say that HE IS the Sabbath.</i></p> <p><b>What would you say?</b></p>

<p>Someone asks...</p> <p>Why did the Hebrews do animal sacrifices in the Old Testament?</p> <p><b>Please explain.</b></p>	<p>A Christian asks...</p> <p>If my (loved one) didn't accept Messiah in their heart, will they go to hell when they die?</p> <p><b>What would you say to them?</b></p>
<p>Someone asks...</p> <p>If the Holy Spirit is not a separate being, what is it?</p> <p><b>Please explain.</b></p>	<p>Someone you know just lost a loved one and they know you are a believer, they ask you, "is my (loved one) in heaven now?"</p> <p><b>What do you tell them?</b></p>
<p>Someone says to you during a conversation about the bible...</p> <p>The bible is full of mistakes and it was written by men. How can I believe what it says?</p> <p><b>What would you say?</b></p>	<p>You're at the grocery store see a family of which all the ladies have long skirts. You presume them to be messianic and want to speak to them. They tell you that they dress modestly and know of the holy days but although they know Sunday is not the Shabbat and Saturday should be, they do like sanctify Sunday in some way. They also believe we don't need to keep the Torah.</p> <p><b>What do you tell them?</b></p>
<p>You're at the grocery you see two Mormons shopping, you identify them by their name tags which read 'elder....' you want to engage them in conversation so you ask them what they are elders of. Thinking they have the opportunity to witness to you they start to tell you about their beliefs. They say Joseph smith was the prophet of the regathering. He was the one who brought Ephraim and Judah back together and to continue the ordination of [Jesus] because the ordination had been lost sometime in the past. Also that the book of Mormon is the 2nd witness of the bible. <b>What do you tell them so they know the ordination was never lost and all we need is the scriptures?</b></p>	<p>You have acquaintance with two Muslim Arab ladies. One asks are you Christian, Muslim or a Jew. You explain to her that you keep the whole bible. Jews just the Torah and Christians just the New Testament. Not understanding the one brushes it off and says "one Elohim for everyone". You know you can't agree that each religion worships the same Elohim, <b>but what do you tell her?</b></p>
<p>You have a Jewish friend who is secular but says he says his prayers. He also said that He believes In Elohim but he just doesn't know "The way".</p> <p><b>What can you say to him?</b></p>	<p>A coworker you have is a seventh day Adventist. She keeps just the Shabbat. She has read the bible but doesn't believe that Elohim is that strict. She says for instance it's impossible to keep the food laws for everyone because of the different types of meat available around the world. <b>What can you tell her to give better understanding that it's possible to keep the laws?</b></p>
<p>A Jewish coworker you have asks what you believe. When you tell him, he tells you that he used to keep the Sabbath and grew up orthodox. When you ask why he doesn't do it anymore he says he doesn't know. <b>What can you say to show the importance of belief in the scriptures?</b></p>	<p>After having a conversation with a Christian, he brings up that the church replaced Israel in the New Covenant.</p> <p><b>How would you explain to them about replacement theology?</b></p>


<p>Someone asks...</p> <p>How do you drink the wine for the Passover ceremony if you are not allowed to eat leaven during the feast?</p> <p><b>How would you respond?</b></p>	<p>During a conversation, someone asks, what is the congregation's precedent of dual prophecy fulfilled in scripture?</p> <p><b>How would you explain is?</b></p>
<p>Someone asks...</p> <p>Did the apostles of Yahshua write the gospels and epistles in Hebrew?</p> <p><b>What is your answer?</b></p>	<p>A new brother or sister in the faith ask you if there is a difference between precepts, statutes, and commandments</p> <p><b>How would you explain this to them?</b></p>
<p>A messianic asks...</p> <p>Should a woman wear a veil during worship?</p> <p><b>What is your answer?</b></p>	<p>During a casual conversation with a friend, he mentions that he wanted to grow his hair long like our Messiah.</p> <p><b>How can you explain to them that this is against scripture?</b></p>
<p>During a conversation, someone says, "what's the point He already knows what I'm going to do and everything is predestined?"</p> <p><b>What is your answer to this statement?</b></p>	<p>During a conversation someone says that America is the Promised Land and Israel is Babylon.</p> <p><b>How would you respond to this?</b></p>
<p>Someone asks...</p> <p>Can't a believer just baptize themselves? Why do I need someone to do it for me?</p> <p><b>What is your answer?</b></p>	<p>A believer asks...</p> <p>Why was John baptizing without being baptized?</p> <p><b>What is your answer?</b></p>
<p>After talking with a friend they told you that they had already taken baptism in the name of the father, the son and the Holy Spirit and until now they have been following Jesus Christ as their personal savior. They ask you is it necessary to get baptized again in the Name of Yahshua?</p> <p><b>How would you respond to this?</b></p>	<p>Someone asks...</p> <p>If believers aren't promised heaven what is their reward for being faithful?</p> <p><b>What is your answer?</b></p>

<p>A believer asks...</p> <p>Is it still necessary to pay tithes to the church or congregation?</p> <p><b>What is your answer?</b></p>	<p>After speaking with a messianic believer he mentioned that Passover had come early this year because he heard reports that there was Aviv barley in Israel.</p> <p><b>How would you respond?</b></p>
<p>Speaking with a Jewish man he mentioned that the feast of Shavuot is always on Sivan 6 every year.</p> <p><b>How would you respond?</b></p>	<p>During a conversation, someone says, "what you believe and what I believe are all in the same, we all serve the same Elohim. How we do it is the only difference. I believe Elohim created Jesus (Yahshua), such as Allah or any of the others. I believe they all serve the same purpose, for the people of that religion, to follow and lead us to the same end."</p> <p><b>How would you respond?</b></p>
<p>After a casual conversation about food with a friend, you mention that you don't eat pork and they ask if it's for religious reasons.</p> <p><b>How would you respond?</b></p>	<p>Speaking with a Jewish person about your faith they ask you if you keep kosher. You explain to them that you do but don't keep the Jewish Tradition of not mixing milk and meat. After hearing this, they respond sharply to you making the comment "well you don't keep kosher then."</p> <p><b>How would you respond to this statement?</b></p>
<p>A women asks...</p> <p>Should women be wearing tassels like the men?</p> <p><b>What is your answer?</b></p>	<p>During a conversation with a messianic, he mentions that he believes eating chicken is going against the biblical clean and unclean food laws.</p> <p><b>How would you respond to this?</b></p>
<p>After a casual conversation about food with a friend, you mention that you don't eat shellfish and they ask you why.</p> <p><b>What is your answer?</b></p>	<p>During a conversation with a messianic, he mentions that shrimp is a clean animal to eat because they have a tail and the shell on his back is considered a scale.</p> <p><b>How would you respond to this?</b></p>
<p>Someone wants to know more about the Levitical priesthood vs. the Melchizedek priesthood.</p> <p><b>How do explain the changing of the priesthood?</b></p>	<p>Someone says...</p> <p>Where in the Bible does it say that America is Babylon?</p> <p><b>What is your answer?</b></p> <p>Jer 50, 51, Rev 17,18</p>

<p>Someone asks...</p> <p>Who was Melchizedek, who visited Abraham?</p> <p><b>What is your answer?</b></p>	<p>Someone asks...</p> <p>Was there salvation in the old covenant?</p> <p><b>What is your answer?</b></p>
<p>During a conversation with a Christian, they mention, “It really doesn’t matter what we Him, because He knows my heart?”</p> <p><b>How do you tell them about the Names of Yahweh and Yahshua?</b></p>	<p>Someone says...</p> <p>I believe in the trinity – the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit.</p> <p><b>How would you respond to this?</b></p>
<p>Someone says...</p> <p>My pastor told me the Sabbath was changed to Sunday!</p> <p><b>What is your answer?</b></p>	<p>Someone is interested in knowing about covenant relationship and the two covenants.</p> <p><b>What would you say to explain the covenants?</b></p>
<p>Someone says...</p> <p>All food was made clean because it says in the Bible that Peter had a vision in Acts 10 and he told to rise up and eat.</p> <p><b>What would you say to explain the true meaning of Peter’s vision?</b></p>	<p>Someone asks...</p> <p>What is the kingdom of YAHWEH?</p> <p><b>Please explain.</b></p>
<p>During a conversation someone believes they will be saved during the rapture because Noah went into the ark before the flood and Lot was delivered from the destruction on Sodom and Gomorrah.</p> <p><b>What would you say to them?</b></p>	<p>A new believer asks, I divorced my spouse five years ago, can I get married again?</p> <p><b>Please explain.</b></p>

If He wasn't, how would he know what it was like to be married?</p> <p><b>Knowing this is abominable how would you respond?</b></p>	<p>A Christian asks...</p> <p>If Jehovah is not the true name of our creator, why do we call Him this and where did it come from?</p> <p><b>What is your answer?</b></p>
<p>A Messianic asks...</p> <p>Why do you call Messiah Yahshua and not Yeshua?</p> <p><b>How would you answer this?</b></p>	<p>During a conversation, someone believes that Yahshua the Messiah was a Cherub (Angel) and not The Son of Yahweh.</p> <p><b>How would you respond to this?</b></p>
<p>Someone asks...</p> <p>Genesis 5:24 says "And Enoch walked with Elohim. Then he was not, for Elohim took him." Does this mean he is in Heaven?</p> <p><b>What is your answer?</b></p>	<p>Someone asks...</p> <p>According to the bible, is it wrong to drink alcohol?</p> <p><b>How would you answer this question?</b></p>
