



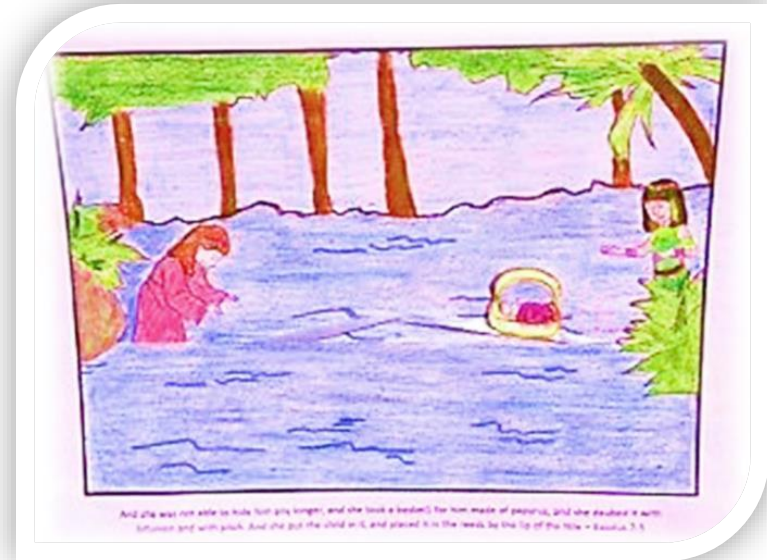
## The Basket of Baby Moses

*And the daughter of Pharaoh went down to bathe at the Nile. And her slave women were walking on the side of the Nile. And she saw the basket in the midst of the reeds, and sent her slave-girl and took it – Exodus 2:5*

### Supplies:

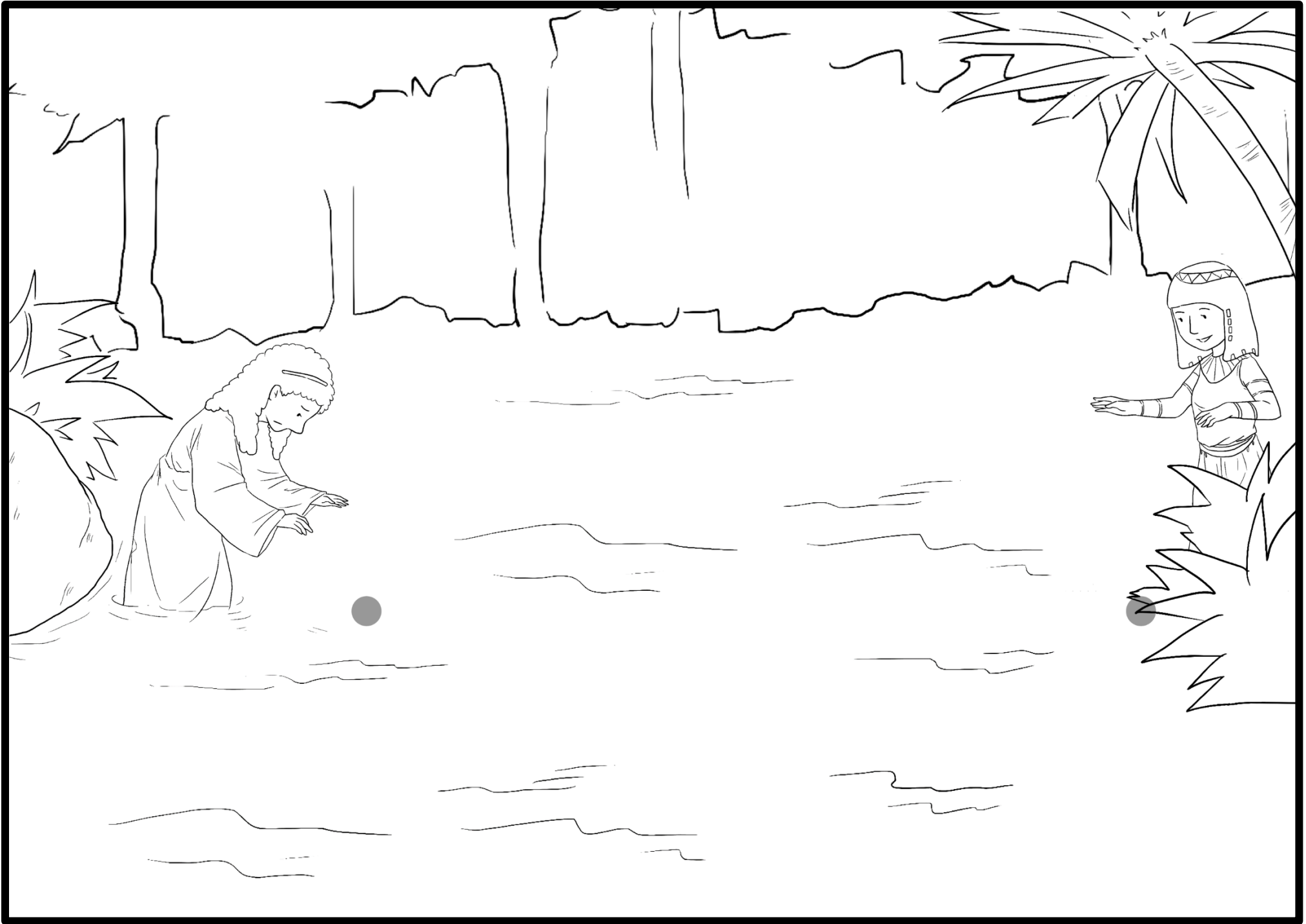
- Scissors
- Colored Pencils, Crayons or Markers
- Glue
- Piece of Cardboard, Same Size as Paper\*
- Ribbon, String or Dental Floss
- Knife or sharp object to cut

\*Cereal Box Works Great



### Instructions:

1. Print, color and cutout the last page.
2. Color the second page and glue it on top of the cardboard.
3. Very carefully and with adult supervision, poke holes through gray dots. **(Make sure you cut through the paper and the cardboard.)**
4. Thread string through holes and tie a knot in the back.
5. Glue the baby picture to the string and let dry.
6. Glue water and plants cutout from the last page, on top of the second page but make sure not to apply glue in the line of motion of the basket. **(For 3D effect, don't apply glue to top of plants.)**
7. Move baby along river by pulling on the string.
