<p><u>Exodus 12:6</u> Kill Passover between 13<sup>th</sup> &amp; 14<sup>th</sup></p> <p><u>Luke 22:7</u> Disciples go to make ready for Passover</p>	<p><u>Exodus 12:11-12, 22, 29</u> People ate Passover, Death Angel passed at midnight on 14<sup>th</sup>, people could not leave house until morning</p> <p><u>Luke 22:8-2-, 52-71</u> Yahshua eats Passover with disciples – is taken from Garden of Gethsemane to High Priest and Pilate</p>	<p><u>Exodus 12:34-37</u> Pilfered Egyptians, hurriedly made bread &amp; left Goshen to Rameses to assemble to leave Egypt</p> <p><u>Mark 15:27-33</u> <u>Luke 23:26-56</u> Yahshua is crucified, put in tomb before sunset of 1<sup>st</sup> day of unleavened bread &amp; Holy Day – Priest and Scribe are watching crucifixion, not killing lambs as they were killed the day before (Luke 22:7)</p>	<p><u>Ex 12:40-42; Num 33:3</u> <u>Deut 15:1</u> People celebrate &amp; leave Egypt on night of 15th, not on Passover night but next night</p> <p><u>Luke 23:56</u> People rested on Holy Day</p>
