"Train up a child on the opening of this way, even when he is old, he will not turn aside from it," Proverbs 22:6


As parents we are given the responsibility to teach the children about Yahweh and His ways.



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## Bible Story Time

#### The Burning Bush and the Name of YAHWEH Exodus 3:1-15

And Moses was tending the flock of his father-in-law Jethro, the priest of Midian. And he led the flock behind the wilderness and



came to **the mountain of the Elohim, to Horeb**.

And the **Messenger of YAHWEH** appeared to him in a flame of fire from the middle of a thorn bush. And he looked, and behold, the thorn bush was

burning with fire, and the thorn bush was not burned up!

And Moses said, I will turn aside now and see this great sight, why the thorn bush is not burned up.

And YAHWEH saw that he



turned

aside to see, and Elohim called to him from the midst of the thorn bush, and said, Moses! Moses! And he said, I am here. And He said, Do not come near here. Pull off your sandals from

your feet, for the place on which you are standing is holy ground.

And He said, I am the Elohim of your fathers, the Elohim of Abraham, the Elohim of Isaac, and the Elohim of Jacob. And Moses hid his face, for he feared to look upon the Elohim.



And YAHWEH said, Surely, I have seen the affliction of My



# What's This? The Mountain of Elohim

The Bible tells us Moses was tending the flock of his father-in-law Jethro, and he came to the mountain of the Elohim which is called Mount Horeb.

In the Arabic language they call this mountain "Jabal Al Lawz.

It means "Mountain of Almonds" in English.

"Jabal" means "mountain" in Arabic, and "Al Lawz" means "almonds."





This name comes from almond trees in the area surrounding the mountain.

When these trees bloom in the spring they have beautiful white flowers.



The top of Jabal Al Lawz looks black because of the dark-colored rocks there.

These dark rocks contain minerals and materials that give them their color.

Basalt, is known for its dark color because of volcanic activity.



Jabal Al Lawz also has different seasons in the area.






In the summer it is very hot.



## The Importance of Names in the Bible

In the bible, names are very important. Many times we see that names may have to do with what you look like, what you will do or how you act (your character).

Yahweh named the first man Adam as he was made from the dust of the ground and was ruddy or red. Adam named his wife Eve (Chavah) which means she became the mother



of all living. There are times when Yahweh changes a person's name to show what a person will do. Abram which means exalted Father (Yahweh), was changed to Abraham meaning the father of many.



Yahshua also changed the names of some of the apostles when he called Simon, Peter, rock. Some people changed their own names as Shaul became Paul.

There are a few people who are named after how they act, for example, Abigail's husband was named Nabal which means fool as he acted foolishly against David (*1 Samuel 25:25*).

But the most important names to remember are those of Yahweh and Yahshua. Moses wanted to know the name of the one true Elohim as he had been raised in Egypt where they had many elohim. Also, in the name Yahshua, there is salvation in no other man for neither is there any other Name under Heaven having been given among men by which we must be saved.



Thank you Yahweh for protecting us in the shadow of Your








What faith Elijah had to go and live where Yahweh commanded him to.



Ravens are extremely smart and great problem solvers. They have been known to use tools to obtain food and aid in defending their territories.

Ravens are very talkative, there are over 30 vocal sounds that have been recorded. And, they are excellent at mimicking sounds, such as other animal calls, car alarms, sirens and even human speech!

Ravens can live in many different environments ranging from urban areas and forests to high deserts and tundra.



Ravens like to hide their food from other predators, even other ravens. They often "pretend" to hide food in a safe place while another raven is watching — only to move the food to another location when unobserved!




They have impressive memories, like humans and other primates and it allows them to remember human faces and other characteristics such as emotion. They can even hold grudges whenever they are cheated or tricked.



They look a lot like crows. However, ravens are heavier and have bigger bills. They can measure up to 26 inches (66 centimeters) in length. They love to play and have been seen doing funny things. They even make toys and like to taunt other animals just to have fun.







# Homemade Granola

# You Need

Recipe

## Dry Ingredients

- \* 4 1/2 Cups of oatmeal
- \* I Cup of dried fruit dates, raisins, etc.
- \* 2 Cups of nuts Almonds, pecans, etc.

## Syrup Ingredients

- \* ¾ Teaspoon baking soda
- \* 1/3 Cup raw cane sugar
- \* 1/3 Cup of honey
- \* ¼ Teaspoon of salt
- \* 1 1/2 Teaspoon of Vanilla
- \* 1/3 Cup of butter or coconut oil



# I. Mix

Combine and mix all dry ingredients in a large bowl.

\*Preheat oven to 325°F (160°C)



# 2.Syrup


#### \*With help from an adult\*

Add butter or coconut oil to a saucepan over medium heat. Stir in brown sugar, honey and salt. Bring the mixture to a boil and once boiling, remove from heat and stir in baking soda and vanilla.

# 3. Mix

Pour syrup over oatmeal mixture and mix until everything is covered.





4. Bake

# 5. Cool

Remove pan from oven and use a spoon or spatula to press the hot granola firmly



down into the pan. Allow to cool completely.







- **1**. Cut out 7 leaves on the green paper.
- 2. Poke a hole through the bottom of each leaf and insert the end of the piper cleaner to hold the leaf. Curl the end over once it is through the leaf.




- **3**. Poke 5 holes around the toilet paper roll and insert your branches. Curl the ends on the inside of the roll to hold them in place.
- **4**. Cut long strips of orange and yellow tissue paper and crumble lightly into a loose ball. Set inside the top of the toilet paper roll and gently pull out some of the strip to hang over the sides.
